 - Accepted papers for presentation should reach us by 15th April 2018. Complete papers should be in MS word format with relevant documentation.
 - Registration Fee: Rs.2000/- per participant payable after acceptance of paper. For research scholars Rs.1000/-, Students presenting paper Rs.500/-, Observers Rs.200.
- For foreign participants \$200/-. Research scholars \$100.
